MCCNY Charities and Metropolitan Community Church of New York are proud to offer free, confidential rapid HIV testing at 446 West 36th Street, between 9th and 10th Avenues. Rapid HIV testing will be available to all, with no ID or appointments required. Results will be available in under 20 minutes. Those receiving tests will have the choice of either oral or whole blood testing. Those receiving preliminary positive results will have the option of receiving a second test, and will also be connected to comprehensive follow-up care through the William F. Ryan Community Health Network.
