CREATING A LIFE THAT MATTERS is a three-course curriculum which explores ways to rediscover relationship with the Sacred, with my Self, and with my Passion.

CREATING A LIFE THAT MATTERS challenges participants to broaden their understanding of all that is Sacred; employ their self-awareness as authentic, engaged leaders; and live their passion intentionally through the life and work of the church.

CREATING A LIFE THAT MATTERS integrates art, scripture, music, literature, film, journaling, and diverse spiritual resources to augment our exploration of the Christian path.
