Ecclesiasticus 15: 15-20

The Second Lesson

Mateo 5: 17-37

Matthew 5: 17-37

Jesús dijo, "No crean ustedes que yo he venido a suprimir la ley o los profetas; no he venido a ponerles fin, sino a darles su pleno valor. Pues les aseguro que mientras existan el cielo y la tierra, no se le quitará a la ley ni un punto ni una letra, hasta que todo llegue a su cumplimiento. Por eso, la persona que no obedece uno de los mandatos de la ley, aunque sea el más pequeño, ni enseña a la gente a obedecerlo, será considerado el más pequeño en el reino de los cielos. Pero la persona que los obedece y enseña a otros a hacer lo mismo, será considerado grande en el reino de los cielos. Porque les digo a ustedes que, si no superan a los maestros de la ley y a los fariseos en hacer lo que es justo ante Dios, nunca entrarán en el reino de los cielos. Ustedes han oído que a sus antepasados se les dijo: 'No mates, pues la persona que mate será condenado.' Pero yo les digo que cualquiera que se enoje con un hermano o una hermana, será condenado. La persona que insulte a un hermano o una hermana, lo juzgará la Junta Suprema; y la persona que injurie gravemente a un hermano a una hermana, se hará merecedor del fuego del infierno. Así que, si al llevar tu ofrenda al altar te acuerdas de que tu hermano o tu hermana tiene algo contra ti, deja tu ofrenda allí mismo delante del altar y ve primero a ponerte en paz con tu hermano o tu hermana. Entonces podrás volver al altar y presentar tu ofrenda. Si alguien te lleva a juicio, ponte de acuerdo con él mientras todavía estés a tiempo, para que no te entregue al juez; porque si no, el juez te entregará a los guardias y te meterán en la cárcel. Te aseguro que no saldrás de allí hasta que pagues el último centavo. Ustedes han oído que se dijo: 'No cometas adulterio.' Pero yo les digo que cualquiera que mira con deseo a una persona, ya cometió adulterio con la persona en su corazón. Así pues, si tu ojo derecho te hace caer en pecado, sácatelo y échalo lejos de ti; es mejor que pierdas una sola parte de tu cuerpo, y no que todo tu cuerpo sea arrojado al infierno. Y si tu mano derecha te hace caer en pecado, córtatela y échala lejos de ti; es mejor que pierdas una sola parte de tu cuerpo, y no que todo tu cuerpo vaya a parar al infierno. También se dijo: 'Cualquiera que se divorcia de su esposa, debe darle un certificado de divorcio.' Pero yo les digo que si una persona se divorcia de su esposa, a no ser en el caso de una unión ilegal, la pone en peligro de cometer adulterio. Y la persona que se casa con una divorciada, comete adulterio. También han oído ustedes que se dijo a los antepasados: 'No dejes de cumplir lo que hayas ofrecido a Dios bajo juramento.' Pero yo les digo: simplemente, no juren. No juren por el cielo, porque es el trono de Dios; ni por la tierra, porque es el estrado de los pies de Dios; ni por Jerusalén, porque es la ciudad del gran Gobernante. Ni juren ustedes tampoco por su propia cabeza, porque no pueden hacer blanco o negro ni un solo cabello. Baste con decir claramente 'sí' o 'no'. Pues lo que se aparta de esto, es malo."

TE ALABAMOS, O DIOS

Jesus said, "Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have come not to abolish but to fulfill. For truly I tell you, until heaven and earth pass away, not one letter, not one stroke of a letter, will pass from the law until all is accomplished. Therefore, whoever breaks one of the least of these commandments and teaches others to do the same will be called least in the reign of heaven, but whoever does them and teaches them will be called great in the reign of heaven. For I tell you, unless your righteousness exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never enter the reign of heaven. You have heard that it was said to those of ancient times, 'You shall not murder,' and 'whoever murders shall be liable to judgment.' But I say to you that if you are angry with a brother or sister, you will be liable to judgment, and if you insult a brother or sister, you will be liable to the council, and if you say, 'You fool,' you will be liable to the hell of fire. So when you are offering your gift at the altar, if you remember that your brother or sister has something against you, leave your gift there before the altar and go; first be reconciled to your brother or sister, and then come and offer your gift. Come to terms quickly with your accuser while you are on the way to court with them, or your accuser may hand you over to the judge and the judge to the guard, and you will be thrown into prison. Truly I tell you, you will never get out until you have paid the last penny. You have heard that it was said, 'You shall not commit adultery.' But I say to you that everyone who looks at someone with lust has already committed adultery in their heart. If your right eye causes you to sin, tear it out and throw it away; it is better for you to lose one of your members than for your whole body to be thrown into hell. And if your right hand causes you to sin, cut it off and throw it away; it is better for you to lose one of your members than for your whole body to go into hell. It was also said, 'Whoever divorces, let them give a certificate of divorce.' But I say to you that anyone who divorces, except on the ground of sexual immorality, causes their spouse to commit adultery, and whoever marries a divorced person commits adultery. "Again, you have heard that it was said to those of ancient times, 'You shall not swear falsely, but carry out the vows you have made to God.' But I say to you: Do not swear at all, either by heaven, for it is the throne of God, or by the earth, for it is the footstool of God, or by Jerusalem, for it is the city of the great Ruler. And do not swear by your head, for you cannot make one hair white or black. Let your word be 'Yes, Yes' or 'No, No'; anything more than this comes from the evil one."

AFRICAN AMERICAN HISTORY MONTH

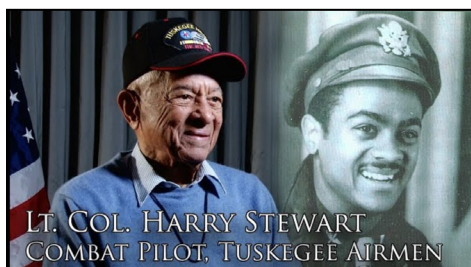
2026 National Theme: *"A Century of Black History Commemoration"*

2026 marks the 100th anniversary since Dr. Carter G. Woodson established the first commemoration of "Negro History Week." This year we celebrate the resilience, achievements, and influence of African Americans on American History.

In 2025, Americans, as well as people around the globe, mourned the deaths of several influential African American figures in the fields of music, politics, acting, and activism.



Charles B. Rangel was a politician who served as a U.S. Representative from New York for 46 years. He was the 1st African American to chair the influential House Ways and Means Committee, and a founding member of the Congressional Black Caucus.



Lt. Col. Harry Stewart, Jr. was an officer in the U.S. Army Air Forces and a distinguished Flying Cross Recipient. He served as part of the African American Tuskegee Airmen. Nicknamed "Red Tails" for the markings on their airplanes, 1,000 pilots and 13,000 support staff shattered racial barriers in the armed services during World War II.
